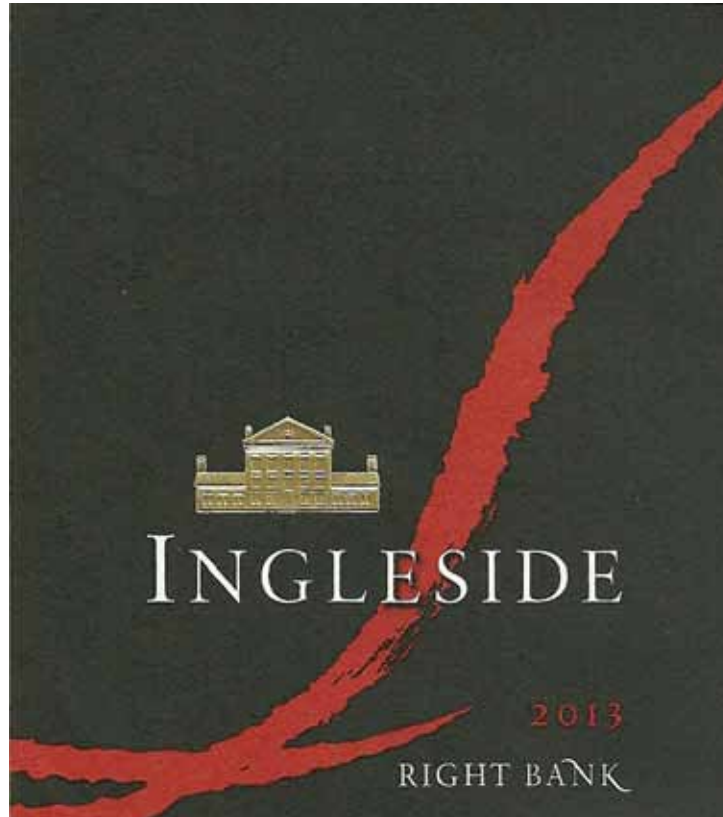


# RIGHT BANK 2013



Varieties:	75% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Petit Verdot
Bottled:	March 25, 2015
Production:	307 cases
Alcohol Content:	13.9%

**Wine Maker's Notes:** This hand crafted, Bordeaux-style blend was inspired by wines produced on the right bank of the Gironde River in Bordeaux, France. These wines are traditionally Merlot-based blends with a soft, rich mouthfeel and complex red berry fruit aromas. Our version is inspired by that profile while reflecting the true nuances of Virginia terroir.

**Aging and Fermentation:** Classic eleven day fermentation on the skins with pump-overs daily, followed by the traditional malolactic fermentation to soften the wine. Aged in French and American oak barrels.
