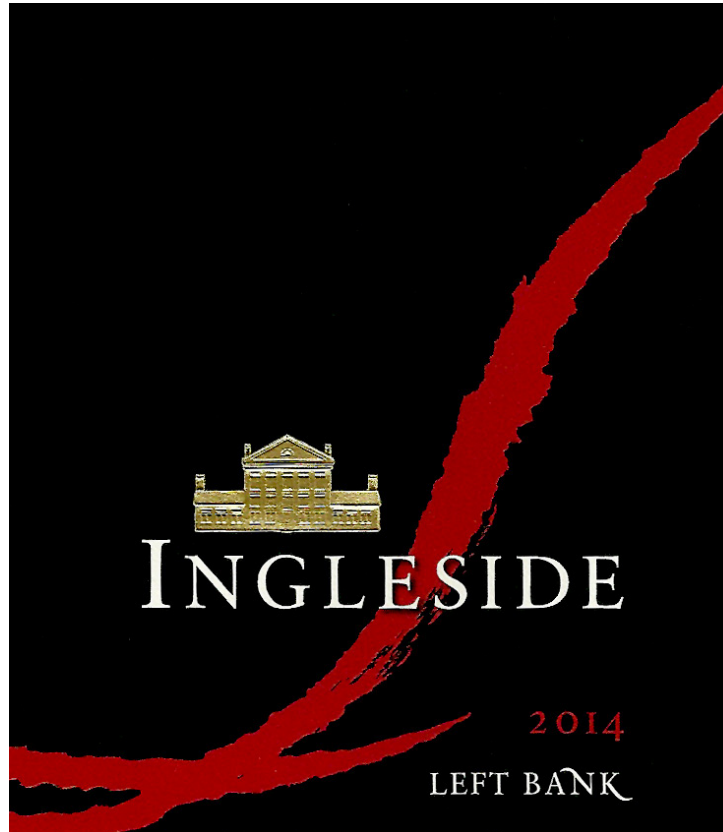


LEFT BANK 2014



Varieties: 50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Cabernet Franc, 20% Petit Verdot,
10% Merlot
Bottled: June 17, 2016
Production: 208 cases
Alcohol Content: 13.1%

Wine Maker's Notes: This hand-crafted red was inspired by the wines of the left bank of the Gironde River in Bordeaux France. These wines are traditionally Cabernet Sauvignon-based with a smoky mouthfeel and complex blackfruit and berry aromas. Our version reflects the true nuances of Virginia terroir.

Aging and Fermentation: Classic eleven day fermentation on the skins with pump-overs daily followed by the traditional malolactic fermentation to soften the wine. Aged in French and American oak barrels.
