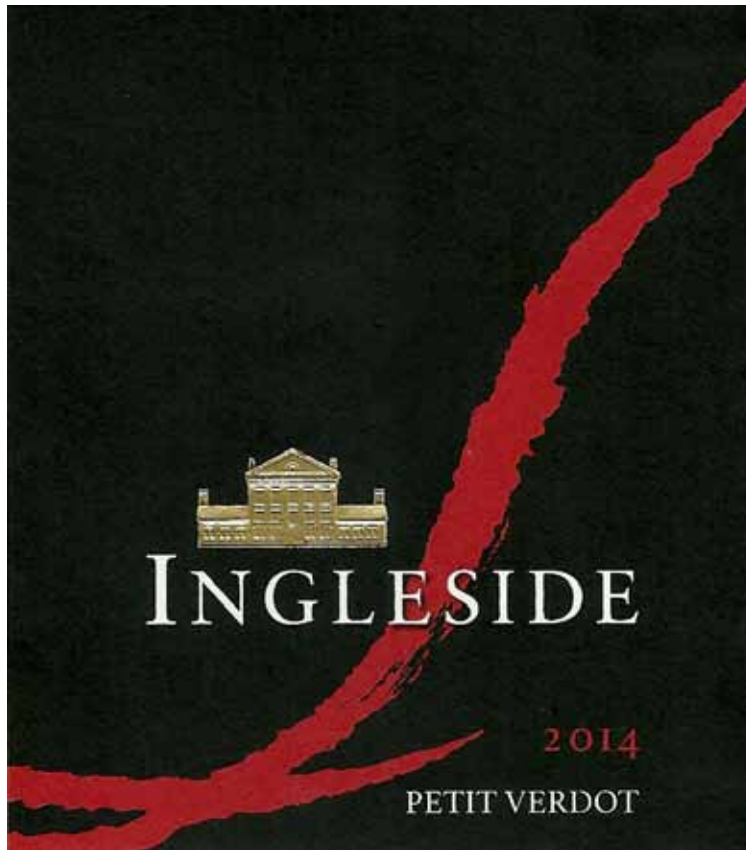


PETIT VERDOT 2014



Varieties: 75% Petit Verdot, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Cabernet Franc
Bottled: June 17, 2016
Production: 218 cases
Alcohol Content: 14%
Residual Sugar: 0%

Wine Maker's Notes: This bold Bordeaux-style Petit Verdot explodes with dark cherry and blackcurrant notes on the nose. Earth-driven, bold and structured notes of raspberry, black fruit and spice dominate on the palate. Recommended for red meats and hearty meals; best served at approximately 60 degrees Fahrenheit.

Aging and Fermentation: Classic fourteen day fermentation on the skins with pump-overs daily followed by the traditional malolactic fermentation to soften the wine. Aged in French and American oak barrels.
