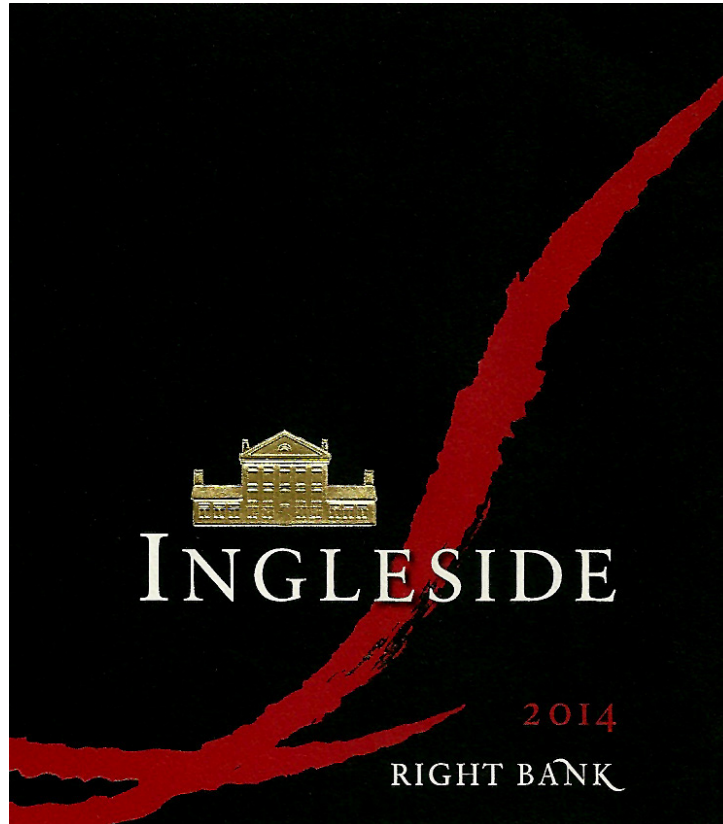


RIGHT BANK 2014

Wine Maker's Notes: This hand crafted, Bordeaux-style blend was inspired by wines produced on the right bank of the Gironde River in Bordeaux, France. These wines are traditionally Merlot-based blends with a soft, rich mouthfeel and complex red berry fruit aromas. Our version is inspired by that profile while reflecting the true nuances of Virginia terroir.

Aging and Fermentation: Classic eleven day fermentation on the skins with pump-overs daily, followed by the traditional malolactic fermentation to soften the wine. Aged in French and American oak barrels.
